| | | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Development players should be scouted to eventually play in SL <p>After discussion the meeting agreed the following;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There would be a Super League (SL1, SL2, SL3) grades and an Open League (OL1, OL2, OL3 etc) grades • In principle Super League grades would be subject to all current conditions within the current VWA By-Laws (noting the amendments to specific by-laws) • The Open League grades would be subject to the following; <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ 3 full sets compulsory. ○ Reduced duties – Top Referee, Second Referee and Scorer. ○ No transfer fees (excluding Persons of Interest / Un-financial members). ○ Coaches – Level 0 Beginners as a minimum, noting that in VA language that this is Level 1- Foundation. Candidate Coaches will be accepted pending completion of their accreditation by the end of the WAVL season – if not they will be fined accordingly. ○ Referees – District level Referee for the Top Referee. No payment for Open League Referees. ○ Players may wear tape on their shirts. ○ No development players in Open League. ○ Open League will allow late nominations up until the third week (but no points). | |
