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		<p>4.2 WAJVL</p>	<p>-</p> <p>The committee decided to discuss the possibility of proposing regulations for Junior players playing WAVL and how to make it compulsory for players to go through Junior league before entering WAVL. It was pointed out that the new generation is more responsive to respect the pathway of going through Junior league and then WAVL. The committee agreed that only club/Associations should compete in WAVL, whereas both clubs and schools should compete in WAJVL</p> <p>The committee decided that Junior league will run over 1.5terms from the 5th of May to the 24th of November 2017with a come and try round 9 on the 30th of June 2017.</p>										

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			<p>In regards to schools cup, the committee suggested to pass on a proposal to all the schools with a deadline date to reply back. The point is to discussed the proposed format which is an all-day competition splitting upper schools (YEAR 11& 12). Scheduled on the night of Friday 25th and 26th August 2017 and have a separate date for year 7,8,9,10 schedule on the 15th 16th and 17th of September 2017</p> <p>The main reason behind splitting the schools cup was to move away from other sports finals.</p> <p>The survey will be collected on the Friday in week 1 of term 4 just after schools break.
