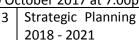






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The VWA Board noted the following documents;

The VWA Board also noted that no further information had been provided by Volleyball Australia in relation to their Strategic Planning process for the 2018 – 2021 cycle.

After discussion the VWA Board agreed the following;

- An in principle agreement to the VWA Strategic Plan 2018 2021 (Final Draft), noting that
 this document would be ratified at the VWA Board meeting in December after RK and IP had
 had the opportunity to attend the Volleyball Australia National Stakeholders meeting in late
 November 2017.
- The VWA Board discussed the importance of reviewing the VWA Staff team composition to align with the priorities and outcomes contained within the Strategic Plan and agreed that there would need to be a number of new positions and also a realignment of a number of current positions. To this end it was agreed that RK, IP and SR would meet to discuss this matter further and provide recommendations and the financial impact analysis to the rest of the VWA Board. It was agreed that this would need to be done as soon as possible which meant that this approval (or otherwise) would need to occur via an email process.
- RK noted that Kyle West (VWA Pathways Manager) has provided his resignation from VWA as
 of the 15 December 2017 as he will be relocating back to Queensland. The VWA Board
 thanked Kyle for all his work and wished him well on his return to Queensland.
- RK also noted that Sam Timmerman (VWA Media Officer) had indicated that he would be relocating to Canada in February 2018.
