It was noted that this had been impacted on by the decision by Volleyball Australia to significantly reduce the requirements pertaining to school students needing their Level #1 Referee accreditations.	
		It was also noted that the Level #2 numbers for Referees had remained stable although this has not seen the increase as included / required in the VWA Strategic Plan Outcomes.	
		It was further noted that the Level #2 and above numbers of coaches had actually decreased by 27 coaches.
