# **TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS**





Representation at the ATA WA Country State Championships will be provided for Regional Associations only.

## 1. Conditions of entry

- a) The tournament is open to all Volleyball WA affiliated regional associations.
- b) If a team pulls out after nominations have closed, the team is still required to pay the tournament nomination fee.

#### 2. ATA WA Country State Championship Tournament Rules

- a) Volleyball WA reserves the right to re-grade teams if required.
- b) Preliminary matches are best of five sets or 50 minutes time limit, which ever occurs first. (Plus warm up of 10 minutes.) The deciding set (3<sup>rd</sup> or 5<sup>th</sup> set) only applies if one of the teams has reached 8 points <u>and</u> is 2 points ahead. A draw will occur if it is 1 or 2 sets all and neither team has reached 8 points with a 2 point lead in the unfinished set. Semi Finals will also be 50 minutes maximum, plus 10min warm up. **State Championship Finals will be best of 5 sets, untimed.**
- c) Sets 1-4 are won by the team that scores 25 points with a minimum lead of two points. Set 5 is won by the team that scored 15 points with a minimum lead of two points. All sets are uncapped.
- d) All games will be run to the central clock, except the State Championship Grand Finals which are untimed.
- e) 10 MINUTE WARM UP PROTOCOL
  - T 10min Official Protocol commences (Players are peppering)
  - Coaches check and sign the score sheet.
  - T 8min Coin Toss
  - Both captains need to sign the score sheet after the coin toss.
  - T 7min Warm up at the net commences, from position 4. Teams need to be in their full playing uniform.
  - T 4min Change hitting warm up to position 2
  - T 2min Serve
  - T 1 min Warm up at the net finishes.

Teams clear the court

- T 30sec Referee calls on teams to enter the court.
- T 00 First whistle to authorise serve

After the referees have called the teams to line up for the start of a game, if six players are not present the following applies;

- The game can be played with five players.
- The game will be forfeited if there are not five players available to play.





















- f) Each team is permitted only one time-out for every set of the match. No time-outs are permitted in the final five minutes. State Championship Finals are permitted two time outs per team per set.
- g) Teams are permitted 12 substitutes per set and each player may make 3 entries on the score sheet. The starting line up counts as the first entry.
- h) Uniform: All players must play in matching, numbered playing tops. The Libero must wear a shirt of similar style but contrasting colour.
- i) Duty teams are to supply 5 officials:
  - 1 qualified first referee
  - 1 second referee
  - 2 lines persons
  - 1 scorer

Failure to comply will result in the deduction of 1 premiership point per infringement.

#### 3. VWA Membership Conditions

- a) Players must be members of Volleyball WA and they must also be members of their respective club or association.
- b) Athletes who are currently a member of a metro club may play for their country region of previous residence.
- c) Athletes currently a member of a country association who are not putting forward a team, are able to represent a different country association upon completion of an event release form.

### 4. ATA WA Country State Championship Awards

- a) Most valuable player votes will be on a 3, 2, 1 basis. In the case of a tie, the player with the most "3" votes will be declared the winner.
- b) Premiership points will be awarded as follows:

Win 3 points
Draw 2 points
Loss 1 point
Forfeit -1 point

- c) In the case of two teams being on equal points, the placing will be decided by:
  - i. Win % (total games won/total games played)
  - ii. Set % (Total sets won / Total sets played)



















- iii. Points % (Total points won / Total points played)
- iv. Winner of previous encounter
- d) Medals and trophies will be awarded as follows:

All divisions

- State Champion
- State Championship Runner Up
- MVP
- e) There will be a Perpetual Shield, which will record the winners from each division. This shield will remain at Volleyball WA's State Office. Points for this will be allocated as follows:

A Grade	B Grade
1 <sup>st</sup> – 50 points	1 <sup>st</sup> – 30 points
2 <sup>nd</sup> – 40 points	2 <sup>nd</sup> – 20 points
3 <sup>rd</sup> – 30 points	3 <sup>rd</sup> – 10 points
4 <sup>th</sup> – 20 points	4 <sup>th</sup> – 5 points
5 <sup>th</sup> – 10 points	5 <sup>th</sup> – 3 points
6, 7, 8th – 5 points	6 <sup>th</sup> – 2 points

f) There will be a WA Country State Champions Perpetual Shield, which will be awarded to the Club/Association that acquires the most points as allocated above.
