Increased labour Costs compared to previous season, not enough extra entries to offset this.

Ways to reduce labour cost - Pitching to players regarding pack down (volunteer players), Option of putting question in nomination form.

New sand into Inner City Beach can allow one round to be played there.

Labour costs are expensive hence moving a round to ICB may help reduce overall expenditure

Roughly 50% increase in total nomination fees but all went to Workforce.
