Teams 1 & 2 were the teams relegated from State League Reserve Grading. Teams 3-10 were based on Division 1 results from 2022. Teams 11-17 were randomly drawn out of a hat having not played in State League Reserves in 2022.

WAVL Division 1 Men's Grading

Teams that finish first in their pool will remain in Division 1. Teams that finish fourth in Pool D and Pool E will be relegated to Division 2. Teams that finish second or third in their pool will have a playoff game. Winners of the playoff game will remain in Division 1 whilst teams that lose will be relegated to Division 2.

Ranking System

To determine rankings within the pool after the conclusion of pool play the following are used:

Win ratio

The team with the highest win ratio (to three decimal points) will be awarded the higher placing in the Round Matches:

$$\text{Win ratio} = \frac{\text{Matches won}}{\text{Matches played}}$$

In the case of the teams being on equal wins at the end of the Pool Matches the following applies:

Sets ratio

If teams are tied on points, the order of ranking will be determined by Sets Ratio. The team with the highest set ratio (to three decimal points) will be awarded the higher placing in the Round Matches:

$$\text{Set ratio} = \frac{\text{Sets won}}{\text{Sets won} + \text{Sets lost}}$$

Point's ratio

If the tie still exists after the calculation of the Sets Ratio, the order of ranking will be determined by Points Ratio. The team with the highest Points ratio (to three decimal points) will be awarded the higher placing in the Round Matches:

$$\text{Point ratio} = \frac{\text{Points won}}{\text{Points won} + \text{Points lost}}$$
