Most have around 6-7 participants. • Schools/Club connections <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Importance of connecting engaged schools to clubs to provide students and teachers a mutual relationship. ○ For lower socio-economic schools in particular, the lack of funds and travel aspect is why many students do not continue with sport outside of school. ○ Having a club come into the school addresses these barriers. ○ To look at as we come closer to 2024 • Silver affiliation <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Looking at adjusting Silver Affiliation into 2024. ○ Out of 410 engaged schools, only 32% are affiliates. ○ Except for the 5% discount on equipment, both RR and KA were unaware of what Silver Affiliation provides for the school when asked. ○ Teachers needing to complete the form for affiliation is a possible barrier. ○ May make Silver Affiliation automatic when a school engages with a VWA event (eg. Schools Cup, clinics) rather than asking if they would like an affiliation – would only need to confirm a school's contact details. ○ As it stands, once a school signs up, the affiliation rolls over every year.
