We believe that volleyball in WA is underpinned by the following values that drive our priorities and initiatives: inclusivity and accessibility, health and wellbeing, community, and respect.

VWA is managed by a Board of Directors, whose role is to translate member needs into a future direction for the sport with help from the VWA staff. Managed by the Chief Executive Officer, staff are split into the following sections:

Key Definitions

In this guide, the keywords and phrases have the following meanings:

Affiliate - A member Club / Association or group of VWA

Affiliation - The process for an organisation to become a member of VWA, in accordance with the VWA constitution and policies

Financial Obligation - A legal obligation on the part of one party to pay another party an amount of money

FIVB - The Federation Internationale de Volleyball, the international governing body for volleyball **Intellectual Property** - All rights subsisting in copyright, business names, names, trademarks (or signs), logos, designs, equipment including computer software, images (including photographs, videos, or films) or service marks relating to VA, VWA or any event, competition, or Volleyball activity of, or conducted, promoted, or administered by VA or VWA. For the avoidance of doubt "Intellectual Property" includes the "Sporting Power" and the rules of the sport of Volleyball

Member State - The entity recognised under the VA Constitution to administer the sport of volleyball in a particular State or Territory of Australia

Officials - Refers to all coaches and referees

Organisations - See Affiliate

Players - Refers to all participants of volleyball, regardless of the level of activity that they access **Recreational events/activities** - Events and activities that do not include training of competitive athletes

Sporting Power - That power delegated to VA by FIVB for the exclusive administration, control, and management of the sport of Volleyball in Australia.

State Sporting Association - See Volleyball WA

Un-Financial - An individual member or organisation that owes money to VWA, VA, another member state or another affiliate.

VA - Volleyball Australia, which is the FIVB-recognised body for the administration, control, and management of the sport of volleyball in Australia.

Volleyball WA or VWA - The entity recognised under the VA Constitution to administer the sport of volleyball in Western Australia.

Western Australia Volleyball League or WAVL - The premier indoor volleyball competition in the state.

Benefits of Affiliation

Professionalism and Credibility

Through affiliation with VWA, your organisation's professional standing will be enhanced. VWA is the only entity authorised to administer the sport of volleyball in Western Australia by VA (and the FIVB) and is recognised as the State Sporting Association for Volleyball in WA by the Department of Local Government, Sport, and Cultural Industries. Individuals looking for a club referral can be assured of the quality of affiliated clubs.

Business Development

The VWA Marketing and Communications team are able to provide support, resources, and tools regarding the following:

Decision Making

Depending on your level of affiliation, you may have voting rights at the VWA AGM (Platinum and Platinum-Regional Affiliates). VWA welcomes involvement from all affiliates in the decision-making process, including representation on the numerous committees and working groups, which can be found on our website, www.volleyballwa.com.au/about-us/.

Insurance

Platinum, Platinum-Regional and Gold affiliates of VWA and their registered volunteers will be covered by Volleyball WA's \$20 million Public Liability Insurance, \$10 million Professional Indemnity Insurance and Personal Accident Insurance while involved in approved volleyball-related activities.

Individuals who have obtained Platinum and Gold memberships will be provided with Personal Accident Insurance cover appropriate for their membership level. Please note that all individual members must be registered with VWA to be eligible for this Insurance. If members are not registered, **all** insurances may become void, including the affiliate's Public Liability and Professional Indemnity cover. If a VWA Affiliate is found to be without appropriate VWA individual memberships, VWA may take action of disaffiliating with the Affiliate.

Administration Support

VWA is able to offer Platinum and Gold affiliates access to the VWA Fortix Club Portal. Through the portal, organisations can manage their memberships, manage teams, establish online event entry, and create mailing lists. VWA is constantly collaborating with clubs to automate processes and reduce administrative workloads, please direct suggestions to development@volleyballwa.com.au.

Marketing and Promotion

As an affiliate, your organisation will be able to access marketing and promotion support. This may include advertising through VWA's social media and VolleyVoice newsletter, advice on promotional activities and access to logos and some VWA photographs.

In order for your organisation to appear within the 'Places to Play' function on the website, we will need to know what programs you offer and the locations. Therefore, please ensure that you complete the 'Places to Play' section of the affiliation form and supply a copy of your logo. If you would like your single/one-off event to be promoted by VWA please complete the Event Sanctioning Form (refer to the **Event Sanctioning Form** on the Fortix Club Portal). Please note to be included in the annual calendar this will need to be completed by **November 1**.

Discover Volleyball

Discover Volleyball is a joint project between VWA and VA to get more people to play volleyball. Focusing on providing entry points into the sport through social play, the Discover Volleyball campaign incorporates a range of programs and products designed to engage both current members and newcomers. With programs designed for kids, juniors, and adults of all abilities, VWA would encourage all clubs to take advantage of the campaign and help people Discover Volleyball. Player Development and Pathways

The Volleyball FTEM (Fundamentals, Talent, Elite & Mastery) pathway aims to provide a range of access points for volleyball players of all ages and abilities. As an affiliate of VWA, your organisation will be able to access support to establish programs and pathways, including:

- School holiday clinics
- Junior development initiatives
- Recreational activities
- Kids Volley (delivered by Spikezone)
- Junior Volley
- Junior Talent Development Academy
- Engagement/diversity activities
- Coach development

Kids and Junior Volley Centres

Kids and Junior Volley are programs designed for beginner-level participants where they can learn in a fun, game-orientated environment. Programs can be delivered at a community centre, school, park, or beach centre.

Running a Kids or Junior Volley program has multiple benefits to the sport and the organisation, including:

- Building a participation base and talent pool
- Income revenue stream
- Development of community partnerships and networks
- Access to new coaches and referees

Recognition as an approved Provider or Centre is only available to VWA affiliates. If you would like to express an interest, please contact <u>juniors@volleyballwa.com.au</u> or complete the Kids and Junior Volley section of the affiliation form.

Social Volley Centres

Social Volley can be run in a variety of locations including indoor facilities, the beach, or parks with a target audience of any adult age. It can incorporate a one-off social event, a term-long social program, or a league.

Being a Social Volley provider includes administrative support and marketing support and VWA can provide templates upon request. The benefits include building a participation base, developing community partnerships and networks and an income revenue stream. Referee and Coach Development

Through the Education Coordinator, your organisation can access specific development opportunities for your referees and coaches. This includes:

Volleyball Australia accreditation courses

- Refresher and development workshops
- Accreditation guidance (including Recognition of Prior Learning)
- Mentoring support
- Observational opportunities
- Resources and information sessions
- Presenter development

VWA wishes to ensure that education is accessible locally and is working with the regional affiliates to have remote and in-person education opportunities. Please contact education@volleyballwa.com.au for more information.

Additional Benefits

Depending on your level of affiliation you may also be entitled to the following:

- ✓ Eligibility to enter into the WA Volleyball League (WAVL) and WA Volleyball Junior League (WAVJL)
- ✓ Volleyshop discount pricing
- ✓ Complimentary kit hire
- ✓ Complimentary Inner City Beach court hire
- ✓ Complimentary VWA Boardroom hire (Platinum/Gold Affiliates only)

Eligibility

Organisations wishing to affiliate with VWA must satisfy the following minimum requirements. The organisation must:

- ✓ Be an incorporated body, incorporated company, or registered business
- ✓ Have an active committee/decision-making structure
- ✓ Ensure that at least one of the sports offered is volleyball (multisport organisations)
- ✓ Be financially stable
- ✓ Comply with all state and federal legislation and VWA-related policies, including but not limited to member protection (including Working with Children Check) and workplace health and safety and provide evidence as requested

At a minimum, Volleyball WA will require the following information for securing VWA Board Approval:

- The proposed Club or Association name
- Constitution
- Most recent Annual Report
- Office bearers/owners of the organisation and other volunteers (refer to the Workforce Matrix)

- Sponsor List
- Working with Children Check Record Keeping
- Submission of Club/Association colours and uniform designs
- A comprehensive list of venues assigned for volleyball activities
- Clear specification of the suburb for conducting volleyball practices
- All other forms and documentation as required
- Payment of the base affiliation fee (if applicable)

Proactive communication and adherence to these guidelines will streamline the approval process, fostering a collaborative approach to enhancing the volleyball community in WA.

Mutual Obligations

Volleyball WA will:

- Energetically and consistently work to maintain and advance Volleyball WA's purpose and mission through integrity, values, quality, and reputation
- Actively capture, engage, and increase participation in the sport of volleyball in Western Australia
- Build the visibility of volleyball in Western Australia through participation, marketing and building effective relationships
- Support and enhance the sustainability of Volleyball WA and its Affiliates by engaging, empowering, and connecting people
- Provide opportunities and ongoing implementation for Talent Identification (TID), Development and High Performance (HP) athletes coaches and officials
- Deliver tournaments and events to the highest standards

In return, Volleyball WA Clubs, Associations and Organisations will support Volleyball WA by:

- Upholding and promoting the affiliation/membership requirements of Volleyball WA and Volleyball Australia as outlined in the Constitution, Policies, and Regulations
- Constitutional modifications including name changes will be subject to the approval of the VWA Board
- Actively promoting the values and mission of VWA and adhering to the VWA / VA Codes of Conduct
- Ensuring all players, coaches, officials, and volunteers have the appropriate Individual Membership and Accreditation (where applicable) to participate in volleyball-related activities
- Meeting all financial obligations under any agreements entered with VWA, including but not restricted to Affiliation

- Complying with all State and Federal legislation and VWA-related policies, including but not limited to member protection (including WWCC) and risk management and providing evidence as requested
- Acknowledging that any person who is un-financial and disqualified by either VA, VWA, another member state, or any other affiliate shall be ineligible for membership or to play in VA/VWA competitions or the competitions of any other affiliated organisation
- Accepting that VWA will maintain a register of members in accordance with the VWA Constitution
- Comply with the intellectual property requirements

When to Notify the Board

Volleyball WA acknowledges the potential for Clubs or Associations to contemplate constitutional and name changes. To facilitate a smooth process, please discuss this with the Club and People Development Coordinator before formalising such decisions, ensuring alignment with VWA Board Approval requirements.

Individual Membership Categories

Affiliate players, participants, officials, and volunteers must also be members of VWA, and all affiliates are responsible for ensuring that all individual membership details (and payments if applicable) are received by VWA. The term of individual membership begins on **April 1** and expires on **March 31** of the following year. Please refer to the Individual Membership Guide for further information. VWA Individual Membership is split into the following categories:

- Platinum Membership
- Gold Membership
- WAVJL Membership (Junior League only)
- Bronze ATABT Membership

High-Performance Athletes may hold a VA membership including 'Volleyroo' or 'Centre of Excellence,' and Coaches, Officials and Committee Members may hold a 'Technical' membership.

Clubs and Organisations Affiliation Categories

In accordance with VWA's Constitution and policies, organisations must be affiliated with the State Sporting Association to be eligible to receive any rights or privileges granted to the organisation.

Affiliation is open to all organisations within WA who wish to participate in and grow the sport of volleyball. The term of affiliation begins on **January 1** and expires on **December 31** each calendar year.



Platinum Affiliation

Suitable for clubs, associations and organisations that wish to access **all** VWA services and benefits.

Key features include:

- ✓ Voting rights at AGM
- ✓ Public Liability Insurance and Public Indemnity Insurance
- ✓ Eligible to enter all relevant VWA events and competitions including the Western Australia Volleyball League (WAVL), WA Volleyball Junior League (WAVJL), ATA Country State Championships, and VWA Social Volley events
- ✓ Eligible to attend the annual VWA Clubs Conference
- √ 10% Volleyshop discount
- ✓ Letters of endorsement
- ✓ Complimentary ICB Court, kit and VWA Boardroom hire
- ✓ Club development support
- ✓ Listing on the VWA website
- ✓ Promotion in Volley Voice

Platinum-Regional Affiliation

Suitable regional clubs, associations and organisations who wish to access the full range of VWA services that are available to them but are limited by their location.

Key features include:

- ✓ Voting rights at AGM
- ✓ Public Liability Insurance and Public Indemnity Insurance
- ✓ Eligible to enter ATA Country State Championships and VWA Social Volley events
- ✓ Eligible to attend the annual VWA Clubs Conference
- √ 10% Volleyshop discount
- ✓ Letters of endorsement
- ✓ Complimentary ICB Court, kit and VWA Boardroom hire
- ✓ Club development support
- ✓ Listing on the VWA website
- ✓ Promotion in Volley Voice

If regional organisations wish to enter WAVL, they must upgrade to a 'Platinum' affiliation.

Gold Affiliation

Suitable for those organisations that only run recreational events/activities and who do not wish to access the full range of affiliation benefits.

Key features include:

- ✓ Public Liability Insurance for the duration of the volleyball event or activity (for example, a six-week social competition)
- ✓ Eligible to enter ATA Country of Origin and other VWA Social Volley events
- ✓ Eligible to attend the annual VWA Clubs Conference
- √ 5% Volleyshop discount
- ✓ Letters of endorsement
- ✓ Complimentary ICB Court, kit and VWA Boardroom hire
- ✓ Club development support (limited)
- ✓ Listing on the VWA website
- ✓ Promotion in Volley Voice (limited)

Gold - Indoor Beach Affiliation

Available to members of the Indoor Beach Volleyball Federation (IBVF) in accordance with the IBVF and VWA Service Agreement.

Silver Affiliation

Specifically targeted to assist and support schools who wish to access VWA-organised school-based events and activities.

Key features include:

√ 5% Volley Shop discount

- ✓ Public Liability Insurance and Public Indemnity Insurance for the duration of the VWA event and Personal Accident Insurance for the school's students (Event Only)
- ✓ Ongoing teacher resources and professional development
- ✓ Eligible to enter Schools Cup and WAVJL
- ✓ Support finding coaches and referees
- ✓ Quarterly schools newsletter
- ✓ Upon request attendance at School Assembly and "Cluster School" volleyball competitions

Bronze Affiliation

Targeted to Clubs, community groups, recreation centres and volleyball providers to work with Volleyball WA on a case-by-case basis, commencing with how we can work together to promote and celebrate the multitude of volleyball opportunities to the Western Australian community.

Key features include:

- ✓ Letters of endorsement (project-based)
- ✓ Information on Coaching and Referee Accreditations
- ✓ Skill development opportunities
- ✓ Ongoing updates on any new VWA events and activities
- ✓ Support to transition to the WA Volleyball League (WAVL)
- ✓ Eligible to enter into VWA Social Volley events
- ✓ Volleyball WA presence at events (E.g. Present medals)
- ✓ Acknowledgement opportunities including VWA website and social media promotions

All of the above affiliation categories allow for an upgrade, should organisations wish to access services and benefits associated with another affiliation category.

Sponsor Conflicts

VWA recognises that organisations already have in place and have an ongoing need to pursue a variety of sponsors. VWA does not seek to limit these sponsors, except in situations where the sponsorship may collaterally damage VA / VWA brands or the goodwill of VA / VWA major sponsors. To avoid any issues with sponsor conflicts, the organisation must provide a list of sponsors as part of the affiliation application. VWA reserves the right to request affiliates to cease sponsorship or sponsorship discussions if the partnership is likely to impact current VWA sponsorship arrangements.

After becoming an Affiliate, any new sponsorship arrangements must be notified in writing to VWA. VWA acknowledgement and (if required) endorsement will not be unreasonably withheld,

but VWA reserves the right to safeguard its peak body sponsorships and goodwill as the highest priority.

Member Protection

VWA places the utmost importance on the provision of safe activities and environments for all. For assistance with Member Protection initiatives, please contact development@volleyballwa.com.au.

Code of Behaviour

The VWA Member Protection Policy Statement provides a 'code of behaviour,' which forms the basis of appropriate and ethical conduct by which everyone must abide. The VWA Member Protection Policy Statement is available on the Volleyball WA website, www.volleyballwa.com.au.

Working with Children Check

In WA, the Working with Children Check (WWCC) is **compulsory** for people who engage in 'child-related work' (paid or voluntary), unless exemptions apply. It is the responsibility of the organisation to comply with the Working with Children (WWC) legislation which includes:

- Ensuring that everyone who needs a WWC Card obtains one <u>https://www.wa.gov.au/system/files/2023-06/wwcc_factsheet_cat12_-</u> <u>categories of child-related work 12 a club association or movement.pdf</u>
- Not engaging anyone in child-related work if they have a negative notice or interim negative notice - https://www.wa.gov.au/system/files/2023-06/wwcc-factsheet-crw04-exemptions-narrowing-of-access.pdf

It is vital to keep records to be able to demonstrate compliance with your obligations under the WWC Act. Information that needs to be recorded securely and confidentially (and required for auditing purposes) includes:

- WWC Check application numbers (where applicable), WWC Card numbers and expiry dates for everyone who requires a WWC Card
- Reasons for exemptions (if applicable)
- All notifications from the WWC Screening Unit
- Any Interim Negative Notice(s) or Negative Notice(s) issued, and the action taken by your organisation

Platinum, Platinum Regional & Gold Affiliates - please ensure that WWCC information is provided on the Workforce Matrix. Failure to provide this will result in your application for affiliation being deemed incomplete. Further information about the WWCC can be found at https://www.wa.gov.au/organisation/department-of-communities/working-children-check.

Child Safeguarding

Every child has the right to discover and enjoy life in a safe environment. It is the duty of organisations engaged in child-related activities to protect children and young people from harm. It is both morally and legally required to protect kids and young people from abuse, discrimination, and harassment. VWA would recommend visiting https://www.dlgsc.wa.gov.au/department/child-safeguarding to complete the Self-Assessment against the National Principles for Child Safe Organisations and find resources for child-safe organisations.

Risk Management

The effective management of risk is a collective responsibility to ensure that the sport achieves its vision and mission. VWA adopts a structured and consistent approach to assess and treat all types of risk, at all levels and for all VWA activities. By understanding and addressing its risks, VWA aims to provide greater certainty and security for its members, employees, volunteers, and stakeholders. Affiliating organisations have a responsibility to ensure that all guidance from VWA is communicated to, and understood by the appropriate members, policies and procedures are adhered to and issues are reported immediately.

VWA has a range of policies and procedures on the website, which have been developed to meet legislative requirements and/or achieve best practice. It is the responsibility of VWA and the affiliate to ensure that policies and procedures are communicated to, understood by, and adhered to by the relevant parties. VWA is also able to assist organisations to review and establish their risk management framework, policies, and procedures. Please contact development@volleyballwa.com.au.

Intellectual Property

By becoming an affiliate of VWA, the organisation acknowledges and agrees:

- That there is considerable goodwill and value in the VWA Intellectual Property
- That the ownership or license to use the Intellectual Property resides with VWA and that VWA has the exclusive legal right to use, license and/or sell the brands and/or Intellectual Property
- It will do all within its power to protect and preserve the Intellectual Property including promptly notifying VWA of any breach or potential breach by a third party
- It will seek the prior written authorisation of VWA to use the Intellectual Property and will at no time alter or amend the integrity of such intellectual property without VWA's prior written approval

VWA agrees that the Affiliate will have a license to use the Intellectual Property if it remains in compliance with the affiliation requirements and any other license conditions that VWA determines relevant.

Non-Compliance

By applying for affiliation, the organisation understands that they are bound under the Constitution and policies of VWA and that VWA is under no obligation to continue affiliation should the organisation fail to uphold their obligations.

Termination of affiliation, either by VWA or the affiliate, will mean the organisation will no longer enjoy the rights and privileges of affiliation from the date of termination.
