4	Zoning blueprint	General Discussion around the Discussion paper <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Clubs are currently being formed as “breakoffs” from existing Clubs, contributing to the high density in certain areas of the Metro.</li> <li>- The high density of Clubs in areas of Perth combined with the low availability of facilities is causing a toxic environment between Clubs in these areas.</li> <li>- Do we need to encourage growth of existing Clubs or encourage new Clubs forming in new areas, or both?</li> <li>- Undersupplied areas need to be addressed and Clubs formed for the overall growth of Volleyball.</li> </ul>
