4.5 WAVL Review Matters

The VWA Board thanked the 19 WAVL Clubs and Associations for attending the WAVL review meetings and sharing their feedback. Each meeting lasted about two hours, with four VWA staff members present. The VWA Board reviewed the results from the WAVL Review Questionnaire.

The VWA Board approved the multi-grading days for Division 2 and



















below as requested (and voted for) by the majority of WAVL clubs and Association. RK noted that in conjunction with the decision-making process a "Pros and Cons" document for the three possible options (Single Grading Day, Multi-round grading process and implementation of Promotion and Relegation for all Divisions) had been distributed.

The VWA Board expressed concerns regarding the following;

- Planning by Clubs / Associations particularly in relation to Facility Bookings.
- Communications to / by Clubs / Associations in relation to the new format and its implementation for the 2025 WAVL season.
- Possible disruption of the sequential pathways between divisions.

The following discussions were also noted;

- A revised membership fee structure for term / quarter-based participation (Kids, Junior and Social) also took place. The financial changes were approved by the VWA Board (Refer Section 7.3).
- Concerns regarding Volunteer workload (s) due to the impact of the WAVL criteria on was deferred to allow more time for VWA staff to address concerns raised.

The VWA Board requested RK issue a WAVL Review Letter to the 19 WAVL Clubs and Associations outlining final decisions for the 2025 WAVL season.
